Golaleh Barzani, DMD - Empire Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Dr. Barzani is a board-certified oral and maxillofacial surgeon, practicing full scope of oral and maxillofacial surgery. Her clinical interests include open TMJ surgery and total joint replacement, TMJ arthroscopy, surgical and non-surgical treatment of TMJ disorders, corrective jaw surgery, maxillomandibular advancement for obstructive sleep apnea, jaw pathology, facial reconstruction, salivary gland pathology, alveolar cleft repair, lingual and alveolar nerve repair, complex facial trauma, bone grafting, onto alveolar procedures, Implants, wisdom teeth, IV sedation and management of myofascial pain syndrome. Dr. Barzani, obtained her bachelor's degree at university of California in Berkeley and attended the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. Her postdoctoral education includes a general practice residency at Staten Island university hospital, an internship and residency in oral and maxillofacial surgery at Brooklyn Hospital Center.
